CUP COMPETITION DRAWS



IMPORTANT NOTES FOR CLUB SECRETARIES and MATCH OFFICIALS

1. Clubs should ensure that all their players are registered in accordance with Cup Rule 17 and their eligibility in accordance with the Junior Cup rule.
2. Clubs are reminded each player must be registered with both Westmorland County FA as well as their respective leagues.
3. Players registered with an FA Premiership Academy or Centre of Excellence are not allowed to participate in the youth cup competitions
4. Clubs are reminded that free dates should be requested in accordance with Cup Rule 8 **and that no free dates will give for Semi Final or Final ties.**
5. Home Clubs and Referees are reminded that the postponement of games should be carried out in accordance with the guidelines on the Westmorland County FA Website (www.WestmorlandFA.com). If the appointed Referee is not available on the day of the game, it is their responsibility to contact the home club.
6. In the event of a game being postponed due to illness, Medical Certificates or letters from school confirming absence on the day before and after the scheduled date must be submitted in support. Letters from parents will not be accepted.
7. The Match Official will inspect players equipment in the dressing room **15 minutes** before kick off, **please ensure that all players are available.**
8. If scores are level at the end of normal time, then Extra-Time will be played. If scores remain level at the end of Extra-Time, kicks from the penalty mark will be used to ensure a result is obtained.
9. The Home Club is required to telephone, e-mail or fax the result to the Westmorland County FA Headquarters within 2 hours after the game.
10. **Result Sheets should be completed in full including goalscorers** and returned with the opponents Match Card to the address below within 3 days of the game. Results will be published on our Website (www.WestmorlandFA.com)
11. Clubs and Match Officials – please acknowledge receipt of the appointment by telephoning or e-mailing the Westmorland County FA Headquarters.
12. Match Officials must arrange to travel all or part of their journey to the game together, at one expense to the home club, whenever possible. Anyone who is unable to do so should contact the Westmorland County FA Headquarters immediately.

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
